Park membership grows

At the last count, there were 82 members of Strathpeffer Residents' Association (SRA)! It is really, good news that so many people have shown their support of the Community Park Project.

You may have seen the display about the Community Park in the Water Sampling Pavilion window in the Strathpeffer Square explaining what we hope to achieve on the waste ground just beyond the school playing field. At the moment the children's park is surrounded by a forest of rosebay willow herb. Children using the equipment can't see beyond the weeds and more importantly they can't be seen either. SRA has been told by The Highland Council that as the equipment wears out it will be taken away. It will not be replaced. In time there will be nowhere in the village for parents to take their children to play... we want to make sure this doesn't happen.

One of the goals for the Community Park is to provide a much, improved play area for young children where there will be seats and benches for adult carers. There will also be facilities for the whole community, teenagers and the adult population, including visitors.

We need as many residents as possible to become members so that we can demonstrate that the community is in favour of the project, so if you haven't already done so please consider joining. Funding organisations will want to see a healthy membership.

- We are not trying to sell allotments or anything else!






